



Graduates in possession of a Professional Accountancy Qualification who wish to obtain MIA certification are required to sit for the Malta Variant examinations of Corporate and Business Law and Advanced Taxation.

The Information below summarises the aims of the syllabus for each paper:

Corporate and Business Law

To develop knowledge and skills in the understanding of the general legal framework, and of specific legal areas relating to business, recognising the need to seek further specialist legal advice where necessary.

Advanced Taxation

To apply relevant knowledge, skills, and exercise professional judgement in providing relevant information and advice to individuals and businesses on the impact of the major taxes on financial decisions and situations.

Examinations are held twice yearly in June and December. Applications are to be submitted to the MIA office by not later than **15 March** for one to be eligible for the June examination session, and **15 September** to be eligible for December examination session.
